**In addition to these seminar paths there will be plenary sessions that cover more general topics such as the calendar, benediction etc. There will also be lectures on subjects of liturgical and theological interest. Each priest delegate will have the opportunity, if he wishes, to be assisted in the private celebration of Low Mass in the traditional rite with an assistant priest. There will be a public Sung or Solemn Mass each day in addition to Lauds and Vespers. A book containing the texts for the public liturgies at the seminar will be given to each participant.**
